Caren Umbarger, a classically trained violinist, began playing at age 5. She earned a BA in Violin Performance from Hamline University and has performed professionally since 1983 in classical chamber groups, the eight-piece show band, Blue Daddies, and The Island Duet. Caren has been a private studio teacher since 1983, was co-founder and Artistic Director of Artistic Youth Ensembles of Minnesota (AYEM), and Artistic Director of the Flagler Youth Orchestra. Also an author, Caren's debut novel, Coming To: A Midwestern Tale, won a 2011 Florida Book Award for General Fiction.

Paul Umbarger is an accomplished vocalist and guitarist who began playing and singing in church groups at age 10. After graduating with a BA from Duke University, he formed The 'U' Two guitar/vocal duo - the first of many professional musical ensembles he has led, which include: Blue Daddies, an eight-piece rock, rhythm & blues show band; The Fab Forever, a touring Beatle-band; The Uptown Duet, forerunner of The Island Duet; Blue Chips, a rock band in France; and The Island Duet. Paul has been a private studio teacher of guitar, piano, electric bass, and trumpet since 2003. He was Band Director of Lake Country Montessori School, and co-founder and President of AYEM. Paul is also a painter and an arranger/composer, and has written most of the arrangements performed by The Island Duet.





They are both private studio music teachers, giving lessons in St. Augustine Beach.

Caren, a classically trained, professional violinist, has taught violin, viola, and cello since 1983. She served as artistic director of the Flagler Youth Orchestra for three vears.

Caren came from a musical family and started playing the violin at age five. Her grandfather was the principal cornet soloist and assistant conductor for John Philip Sousa. She also is an accomplished
